

The Global Partnership Initiative on Results & Mutual Accountability – GPI R&MA – is the follow-up of the Post-Busan Building Block with the same name. The GPI provides its membership (± 100 members from partner countries, Development Partners and Civil Society) with regular updates on relevant topics. Main activity for the last two years has been the pilot programme on 'enhanced use of country results frameworks'. Objectives of this programme are:

- · How to improve the use of partner country results frameworks
- How to integrate accountability for results at country level in the 2030 agenda
- · How to create effective country-region-global linkages
- How to integrate country planning and financing processes to achieve results

The programme is implemented by three regional platforms working together with 20+ countries. The first results of the programme are presented and discussed at the Second High Level Meeting of the GPEDC in Nairobi late 2016. For the future – 2017 and beyond – the GPI will continue working as a joint group of regions and countries towards better results achievements, taking into account the implementation of the SDGs at country level and the increasing importance of mutual accountability in international cooperation.
